

NEW MANZINI SABI GRASS

Urochloa mosambicensis



High yielding, robust and palatable *urochloa* for tropical and subtropical regions

Ideal for tropical and subtropical beef and sheep farmers, **Manzini is a highly palatable *urochloa* that is tolerant of heavy grazing**, allowing farmers to maximise stock carrying capacity and feed intake for improved animal performance and a higher return on investment.

Manzini provides farmers with excellent and consistent ground cover and growth throughout hot and cool seasons.

This flexibility is due to Manzini's drought resistance and ability to withstand high temperatures, establish rapidly under heat pressure and continuous growth within hot and cool environments (providing not frost affected). If affected by frost, **Manzini will maintain an upright growth habit and not lodge or fall over.**

For best results and planting window flexibility, sow Manzini during the hottest time of year (germination will occur after rainfall).

Breeding

Bred from germplasm sourced by DLF Seeds, Manzini was selected to maintain the purity of a *urochloa*, whilst providing a later flowering date (3 generations of reselections were undertaken).

Seed treatment options

- Envirogro® seed treatment process
- Superstrike® seed treatment

Sowing and Establishment

Manzini diploid sabi grass pasture seed can be sown into similar soil types as Premier digit. This includes sands, sandy loams, clay loams, red clay types and soil with varying fertility levels. Seed should be sown when soil temperatures are 18 degrees and rising. Unlike other tropical grasses, it is advantageous to dry sow Manzini during the hotter months and whilst awaiting post sowing rainfall. Seed should be sown at a depth of 1 to 2 cm (depth of a fingernail) and at a rate of 1 to 8 kg/ha.
